

NBFTA **ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP** **1st YEAR STUDENT**

The New Brunswick Forest Technicians Association will award a \$500.00 scholarship annually to a worthy individual entering a recognised Forest Technician/Technologist Program.

The Public Relations Committee will be responsible for collecting the applications and presenting them to the executive at the fall meeting of each year.

Applications must be received by November 30th of each year to be considered for the scholarship.

The scholarship will be awarded at the discretion of the executive of the NBFTA after reviewing all applicants who qualify for the award by meeting the following criteria.

CRITERIA:

- Applicant must:
 - Be a resident of New Brunswick
 - Have graduated from a New Brunswick High School
 - Include a cover letter
- Applicants will be assessed based on:
 - previous academic work at high school or post-secondary school
 - extra-curricular and community involvement
 - letters of recommendation from former teachers and others who know them well.

Preference will be given to those applicants with direct family members who are NBFTA members in good standing.
