## ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP

### 2nd YEAR STUDENT

The New Brunswick Forest Technicians Association will award a \$500.00 scholarship annually to a worthy individual entering their second year at a recognized Forest Technician/Technologist Program.

The NBFTA secretary will be responsible for collecting the applications and presenting them to the executive at the spring meeting of each year.

Applications must be received by March 1st of each year to be considered for the scholarship, which will be awarded at the graduation ceremony.

The scholarship will be awarded at the discretion of the executive of the NBFTA after reviewing all applicants who qualify for the award by meeting the following criteria.

#### CRITERIA:

Applicant must:

- Be a resident of New Brunswick
- Have graduated from a New Brunswick High School
- Include a cover letter describing why you are deserving of this scholarship

Applicants will be assessed based on:

- Previous academic work at high school or post-secondary school
- Extra-curricular and community involvement
- Letters of recommendation from former teachers and others who know them well.

*Preference will be given to those applicants with direct family members who are NBFTA members in good standing.*
